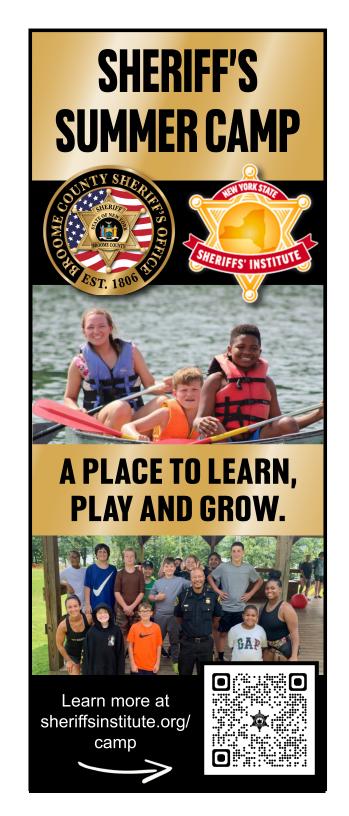

ARE THE DEPUTY SHERIFFS AT CAMP?

Deputy sheriffs play two roles within the camp community. Typically, about 4 to 6 deputies are in residence during each of the six 1-week sessions.

Deputies are essential to the camp's daily curriculum, working hard to project themselves as mentors to the campers. Other deputies visit the camp daily, providing demonstrations of law enforcement techniques and equipment as well as a presentation regarding illicit drugs and alcohol use.
