# Materials Accepted

- Household cleaners & floor care products
- Pesticides & fertilizers
- Automobile fluids (oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, etc.)
- Driveway sealers, pool & photography chemicals
- Fire Extinguishers
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Gasoline & kerosene
- Paint is accepted anytime during normal landfill hours at no charge
- Propane tanks less than 20 pounds
- Computers, monitors, printers
- Televisions, VCRs, modems, stereos - working or not working accepted  
Up to 3 TV's & 3 monitors per resident.
- Laptops, keyboards, radios
- Fax machines, pagers, copiers
- Mobile phones
- Gaming consoles

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Large appliances such as dryers, washing machines, dishwashers, stoves, or microwaves</li> </ul>                             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Accepted by scrap metal recyclers, the landfill, or contact your garbage hauler for details.</li> </ul>   |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Refrigerators, air conditioners and dehumidifiers</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Accepted at the landfill during regular hours for a fee of \$10 per unit.</li> </ul>  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Paint</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Dried out latex paint cans can go in normal garbage</li> <li>■ Paint can be brought to the Landfill, Sherwin Williams, or Greenes Ace Hardware for recycling at no charge.</li> </ul> |
