FINANCE COMMITTEE AGENDA NOVEMBER 6, 2013

Objective: Our primary goals in considering the County Executive's proposed budget were to reduce the proposed property tax increase and to re-direct some resources toward Legislative priorities.

This preliminary version of the Finance Committee's report achieves the goals that we have outlined and reflects the consideration of all items discussed in our meetings with County departments. All initiatives proposed by Committee members and other Legislators that have been received so far, are included in this report. The net impact of the initiatives outlined in this report is to reduce the proposed property tax increase from 2.97% down to 1.77%.

Our report must be final at the end of today's meeting. If any Legislators have proposals that they would like for the Committee to consider, please structure them in the same fashion as the other elements of our preliminary report, which is to say that proposals should be self-balancing, or otherwise result in no net increase to property taxes.
